

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF RUSSELL

By-law # 2021-142

Being an Omnibus By-law to repeal expired, superseded and outdated by-laws.

WHEREAS the purpose of this by-law is to repeal all by-laws, which are identified as:

1. Expired, superseded and outdated, or
2. No longer enforced, or
3. Which deals with subjects now covered by more comprehensive by-laws or provincial legislations; now therefore be it


